## **MATERIALS**

#### 1. Yarn:

Skin color - YarnArt «VIOLET» color № 3000 (50 grams - 282 m, 100% cotton) - 1/8 skein;

Yellow - color № 2123 «IRIS» VITA Cotton (20 grams – 125 m, 100% cotton);

<u>Green</u> – color № 2109 «IRIS» VITA Cotton (20 grams – 125 m, 100% cotton);

White – color № 2101 «IRIS» VITA Cotton (20 grams – 125 m, 100% cotton);

- **2.** Hair Yarn color № 9006 «BAMBINO» NAKO (50 grams 130 m, 25% wool/75% acrylic).
- 3. Hook: 1.0mm (or in accordance with the yarn you use)
- 4. Fiberfill for stuffing
- 5. 3x3 cm cotton fabric.
- 6. Acrylic paints on fabric black, green and white colors.
- 7. Brush paint (thin).
- 8. Tapestry needle
- 9. Glue for fabric.
- 10. Copper wire thickness 1.0-1.2 mm 1.0 meters



## Notes for following my patterns:

# \*\* crochet wrong side facing outwards.


cliet wrong side idenig odtwards

right side



- \*\* Work in spirals. Do not join, slip stitch or turn unless otherwise stated in the pattern.
- \*\* Use a stitch marker in the beginning of each round. This will help to mark the first stitch of every round.
- \*\* Alternative for stitch marker: You can use different colored yarn for stitch markers too. Just place it into the first stitch of every row/round as you go.
- \*\* Alternative for magic ring: Make chain 2. Work 6sc in first chain.
- \*\* Yarn suggestions: If you can not find the same yarn, you can buy a different brand of yarn. It must be anti-pilling yarn. Yarn size will depend on your hook size.
- \*\* If you want my patterns in different languages, check my shop or message me. Flags on my pictures show you the languages of patterns provided.

# sc2tog (decrease):



1. Introduce the hook under the back of the loop № 2 as shown in the photo below:



2. Next, introduce the hook under the back of the loop № 1 as shown in the photo below:



3. Grab the yarn and pull the yarn through 2 loops:



There are 2 loops on the hook. Wrap the yarn and draw through all 2 loops on hook.

# **LEFT HAND**

### Witn skin color

**Round 1:** 6 single crochet in magic ring [6]

Round 2: (sc in each of next 2 sts, 2sc in next st) repeat 2 times [8]

Round 3: sc in each st around [8]

**Round 4:** sc in next st, 2sc in next st, turn, sc in each of next 2 sts, turn, sc2tog, go to the stitches of the 3<sup>rd</sup> row – sc in each of next 6 sts [8]

Round 5: sc in each of next 5 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st [7]

Round 6: sc in each of next 5 sts, sc2tog [6]

Do not stuff the hand with filler.

Rounds 7-19: sc in each st around [6]

Round 20: sc in each of next 2 sts (do not crochet 4 stitches to the end of the round)

Leave the thread 10 cm long and cut.

## **RIGHT HAND**

### Witn skin color

Round 1: 6 single crochet in magic ring [6]

Round 2: sc in next st, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in next st [8]

Round 3: sc in each st around [8]

**Round 4:** sc in each of next 4 sts, 2sc in next st, turn, sc in each of next 2 sts, turn, sc2tog, go to the stitches of the  $3^{rd}$  row – sc in each of next 3 sts [8]

Round 5: sc in each of next 6 sts, sc2tog [7]

Round 6: sc2tog, sc in each of next 5 sts [6]

Do not stuff the hand with filler.

Rounds 7-20: sc in each st around [6]

Leave the thread 10 cm long and cut.



## **RIGHT LEG**

### Witn skin color

Start with ch5

**Round 1:** start in second chain from hook, (1sc in ch1) repeat 3 times, 3sc in next ch, turn the work to continue along the opposite side of the beginning ch, (1sc in ch1) repeat 2 times, 2sc in next st [10]


Round 2: 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, (2sc in next st) repeat 3 times, sc in each of next 2 sts, (2sc in next st) repeat 2 times, BLO - sl st in the first sc [16]

Round 3: sc in each of next 15 sts, 1sc in sl st [16]

Round 4: sc in each of next 3 sts, (hdc2tog) repeat 4 times, sc in each of next 5 sts [12]

Round 5: sc in each of next 2 sts, (sc2tog) repeat 3 times, sc in each of next 4 sts [9]

Take 2 wires 16 cm long. Then bend the wire as shown in pictures below:



Insert the wire in the leg.

**Round 6:** sc in each of next 2 sts, (sc2tog) repeat 2 times, sc in each of next 3 sts [7]

**Rounds 7-8:** sc in each st around [7]

Round 9: sc in each of next 6 sts, 2sc in next st [8]

Round 10: sc in each of next 7 sts, 2sc in next st [9]

Add stuffing.

Rounds 11-13: sc in each st around [9]

Round 14: sc in each of next 6 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st [8]

Round 15: sc in each of next 3 sts, (2sc in next st) repeat 2 times, sc in each of next 3 sts [10]

Add stuffing.

Round 16: sc2tog, sc in each of next 8 sts [9]

Round 17: sc in each of next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in next st, 2sc in next st [8]

Round 18: sc in each st around [8]

Round 19: sc in each of next 7 sts, 2sc in next st [9]

Rounds 20-22: sc in each st around [9]

Round 23: sc in each of next 6 sts, 1 sl st. Fasten off.



## **LEFT LEG**

### Witn skin color

Start with ch5

**Round 1:** start in second chain from hook, (1sc in ch1) repeat 3 times, 3sc in next ch, turn the work to continue along the opposite side of the beginning ch, (1sc in ch1) repeat 2 times, 2sc in next st [10]

Round 2: 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, (2sc in next st) repeat 3 times, sc in each of next 2 sts, (2sc in next st) repeat 2 times, BLO - sl st in the first sc [16]

Round 3: sc in each of next 15 sts, 1sc in sl st [16]

Round 4: sc in each of next 3 sts, (hdc2tog) repeat 4 times, sc in each of next 5 sts [12]

**Round 5:** sc in each of next 2 sts, (sc2tog) repeat 3 times, sc in each of next 4 sts [9]

Insert the wire in the leg.

Round 6: sc in each of next 2 sts, (sc2tog) repeat 2 times, sc in each of next 3 sts [7]

Rounds 7-8: sc in each st around [7]

Round 9: sc in each of next 6 sts, 2sc in next st [8]

Round 10: sc in each of next 7 sts, 2sc in next st [9]

Add stuffing.

Rounds 11-13: sc in each st around [9]

Round 14: sc in each of next 7 sts, sc2tog [8]

Round 15: sc in each of next 3 sts, (2sc in next st) repeat 2 times, sc in each of next 3 sts [10]

Add stuffing.

Round 16: sc2tog, sc in each of next 8 sts [9]

Round 17: sc in each of next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in next st, 2sc in next st [8]

**Round 18:** sc in each st around [8]

Round 19: sc in each of next 7 sts, 2sc in next st [9]

Rounds 20-23: sc in each st around [9]



# **BODY**

**Round 24:** left leg - sc in each of next 3 sts, ch3, right leg - - make a sc into the last stitch (where you made the sl st) of the right leg, sc in each of next 8 sts, (1sc in ch1) repeat 3 times, left leg - sc in each of next 6 sts [24]

Round 25: sc in each of next 3 sts, (1sc in ch1) repeat 3 times, sc in each of next 18 sts [24]

Rounds 26-28: sc in each st around [24]

**Round 29:** sc2tog, sc in each of next 6 sts, (sc2tog) repeat 2 times, sc in each of next 10 sts, sc2tog [20]

Round 30: sc in each st around [24]

**Round 31:** sc2tog, sc in each of next 4 sts, (sc2tog) repeat 2 times, sc in each of next 8 sts, sc2tog [16]

Add stuffing.


Rounds 32-36: sc in each st around [16]

**Round 37:** sc in each of next 16 sts, + 1 sc (offset of the beginning of the row, move the marker, then crochet the 38<sup>th</sup> row, starting from the new position of the marker) [16]



### **Connecting the body with hands:**

**Round 38:** body – sc in each of next 5 sts, connection of the body and right hand – (1 sc in one loop of a body and one loop of a hand) repeat 2 times (as shown in picture below), body – sc in each of next 7 sts, connection of the body and left hand – (1 sc in one loop of a body and one loop of a hand) repeat 2 times [16]





**Round 39:** body – sc in each of next 5 sts, right hand – sc in each of next 4 sts, body – sc in each of next 7 sts, left hand – sc in each of next 4 sts [20]

Round 40: sc in each of next 9 sts, sc2tog, sc in each of next 3 sts, sc2tog, sc in each of next 4 sts [18]


Take 2 wires 7 cm long. Fold the end of the wire is 0.5 cm.



Insert the wire in the arm.



Bend the ends of the wire and hide in the body as shown in the photo below:



Stuff the body and shoulders with fiberfill.

Round 41: (sc2tog, sc in next st) repeat 6 times [12]

Round 42: (sc2tog) repeat 6 times [6]

Fasten off.



# **HEAD**

### With skin color

Rnd 1: 6 single crochet in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each stitch around [12]

Round 3: (2sc in next st, sc in next st) repeat 6 times [18]

Round 4: (2sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts) repeat 6 times [24]

Round 5: (2sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts) repeat 6 times [30]

Rounds 6-14: sc in each st around [30]

Round 15: (sc2tog, sc in each of next 3 sts) repeat 6 times [24]

Stuff the head with fiberfill. Stuffed very tightly, to get a smooth ball.

Round 16: (sc2tog, sc in each of next 2 sts) repeat 6 times [18]

Round 17: (sc2tog, sc in next st) repeat 6 times [12]

Round 18: (sc2tog) repeat 6 times [6]

Rounds 19-20: sc in each st around [6]

Leave a long yarn tail for sewing.



# **NOSE**

## With skin color

Embroider nose between rounds 12 and 13. Length - 1 loop.



# **EARS**

## With skin color

3 single crochet in magic ring, leave a long yarn tail for sewing.

<u>The left ear</u> - to retreat to the left 7 loops from the edge of the nose. Sew the ear between  $10^{th}$  and  $13^{th}$  rows.

<u>The right ear</u> - to retreat to the right 7 loops from the edge of the nose. Sew the ear between  $10^{th}$  and  $13^{th}$  rows.



# **EYES**

Eyes can be embroidered, but here I'll show you how to draw the eyes.

The first time I did not get a nice eyes.

It took me 5 attempts to draw beautiful eyes.

It is better to paint several pairs of eyes in different sizes, so that later you can choose the suitable size eye.


Material fabric - cotton, white. I use fabric from old men's white shirts. Also, this fabric can be

bought in a store.

## Acrylic paints on fabric:



Brush:



Draw the eyes pencil as shown in picture below.



The size of the eyes is approximately 5,0 x 4,0 mm, the width of the head is 3 cm.

Natural size of eyes when printing this sheet.



Draw with black color pupils:



Draw dark green colors iris:



Draw white color white part of the eye:



Mix green paint with white to get a lighter shade of green. Toning iris as shown in picture below:



Draw a glare by white color:



Draw a thin dividing line between the iris and the white part of the eye with black paint or a black marker.



Cover the eyes by transparent lacquer 2 layers. Wait for 1 hour and then cut out the eyes.



Transparent nail polish:

Glue the eyes between rounds 10 and 13.

Glue for fabric:





Embroider the eyelashes with a brown thread -2 eyelashes with the lower part of the eye and 2 eyelashes from the top of the eye.

Embroider the eyebrows between rounds 9 and 10.

Embroider the mouth at the level round 15.



# **HAIR**

Make strands of equal length. Thread length - 16 cm.

Divide the yarn into 2 parts to get the curls.

## Hair fixing:

Insert crochet hook into one of the 'holes' in the dolls head, and out of another straight above it:



Fold a piece of yarn in half and loop it over the hook. Pull the yarn through the holes, but not all the way through:





Pull your yarn over the hook and pull through the loop:





Fasten hair from 1st to 3rd rows of head.

Fixing the hair on the rest of the head in staggered order.



Insert the end of the wire in the head. Sew the head to the body.





# **SHORTS**

### With white color

**Round 1:** start with ch32, 1 sl st into the first chain stitch, ch1, (1sc in ch1) repeat 32 times, sl st in the first sc [32]

Rounds 2-6: ch1, sc in each st around, sl st in the first sc [32]

Round 7: ch1, sc in next st, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 12 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 12 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in next st, sl st in the first sc [36]

Round 8: ch1, sc in each of next 6 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 4 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 12 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 4 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 6 sts, sl st in the first sc [40]

Round 9: ch1, sc in each of next 20 sts, skip 20 sts, sl st in the first sc [20]

Round 10: ch1, sc in each of next 20 sts, sl st in the first sc [20]

Round 11: ch1, (sc in next st, skip 1 st, 5 hdc in one stitch, skip 1 st) repeat 5 times, sl st in the

first sc [30]

With green color

**Round 12:** 30 sl st [30]

Fasten off.



## The second part of shorts

#### With white color

**Round 9:** fix the thread in the 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch from the end of the 8<sup>th</sup> row (as shown in the photo below), sc in each of next 20 sts, sl st in the first sc [20]



Round 10: ch1, sc in each of next 20 sts, sl st in the first sc [20]

**Round 11:** ch1, (sc in next st, skip 1 st, 5 hdc in one stitch, skip 1 st) repeat 5 times, sl st in the first sc [30]

With green color

**Round 12:** 30 sl st [30]

Fasten off.



**Belt** 

## With green color

Start with ch70, fasten off.



# **T-SHIRT**

### With yellow color

Start with ch21

Row 1: start in second chain from hook, sc in each of next 20 sts, ch1 [20]

Row 2: turn, sc in each st around, ch1 [20]

Row 3: turn, sc in each of next 3 sts, 2sc in next st, (2sc in next st) repeat 2 times, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 6 sts, 2sc in next st, (2sc in next st) repeat 2 times, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, ch1 [32]

Row 4: turn, sc in each st around, ch1 [32]

Row 5: turn, sc in each of next 3 sts, 2sc in next st, ch4, skip 8 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 6 sts, 2sc in next st, ch4, skip 8 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, ch1 [28]

Row 6: turn, sc in each of next 3 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 7 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 4 sts, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, ch1 [32]

Rows 7-9: turn, sc in each st around, ch1 [32]

Row 10: turn, (sc in each of next 7 sts, 2sc in next st) repeat 3 times, sc in each of next 8 sts, ch1 [35]

Rows 11-17: turn, sc in each st around, ch1 [35]

Row 18: turn, (sc in next st, skip 1 st, 5 hdc in one stitch, skip 1 st) repeat 8 times, sc in next st, skip 1 st, 5 hdc in one stitch, ch1 [54]

With green color

**Row 19:** turn, 54 sl st [54]

Fasten off.



## **SLEEVES**

### **LEFT SLEEVE**

### With white color

Fix the thread in the 1st missing loop of the right sleeve of the 5<sup>th</sup> row of the T-shirt as shown in the photo below (crochet wrong side facing outwards):



**Row 1:** (2sc in next st, sc in next st) repeat 4 times, go to the chain stitches of the 5<sup>th</sup> row, (2sc in next st, sc in next st) repeat 2 times, sl st in the first sc, ch1 [18]

Row 2: sc in each st around, sl st in the first sc, ch1 [18]

Row 3: (sc2tog, sc in next st) repeat 6 times, sl st in the first sc, ch1 [12]

Row 4: turn, sc in each st around, sl st in the first sc [12]

Fasten off.

### **RIGHT SLEEVE**

#### With white color

fix the thread in the 4<sup>th</sup> chain stitch of the 5<sup>th</sup> row as shown in the photo below (crochet wrong side facing outwards):



Row 1: (2sc in next st, sc in next st) repeat 2 times, go to the missing stitches on the 5<sup>th</sup> row, (2sc in next st, sc in next st) repeat 4 times, sl st in the first sc, ch1 [18]

Row 2: sc in each st around, sl st in the first sc, ch1 [18]

Row 3: (sc2tog, sc in next st) repeat 6 times, sl st in the first sc, ch1 [12]

Round 4: turn, sc in each st around, sl st in the first sc [12]

Fasten off.



Sew 2 buttons or crochet them:

### With green color

6 single crochet in magic ring, sl st in the first sc, leave the thread 25 cm long and cut.

Dress up a T-shirt on a doll. Sew the back seam on the T-shirt.

# **SHOES**

### Sole

With white color

Start with ch5

Round 1: start in second chain from hook, sc in each of next 4 sts, ch1 [4]

Round 2: turn, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, 2sc in next st, turn the work to continue along the opposite side of the chain, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts, 2sc in next st, sl st in the first sc [12]

Round 3: ch1, 2sc in next st, sc in each of next 3 sts, (2sc in next st) repeat 3 times, sc in each of next 3 sts, (2sc in next st) repeat 2 times, BLO - sl st in the first sc [18]

Round 4: BLO – (ch1, sl st) repeat 18 times, fasten off.



### With green color

**Round 4:** fix the thread behind the front of the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch of the 3<sup>rd</sup> row of the sole, sc in each of next 18 sts, sl st in the first sc [18]

Round 5: ch1, sc in each st around, sl st in the first sc [18]

Round 6: ch1, sc in each of next 4 sts, (sc2tog) repeat 4 times, sc in each of next 6 sts, sl st in the first sc [14]

Round 7: 2 sl st, ch5, leave the thread 15 cm long and cut.



Put the shoes on the doll's legs and sew the strap on the opposite side of the shoes.
